





## HOW TO REACH US

-  You can easily reach the Mugello from the A1 motorway, exiting at either Barberino di Mugello or Firenzuola. Alternatively, you can reach the Mugello in less than half an hour from Florence taking one of the two panoramic roads: the Via Faentina or the Via Bolognese.
-  The historical, fascinating Faentina railway line allows you to access the Mugello both from the Romagna side, departing from Faenza and connecting to Marradi, and from the Tuscan side, departing from Florence. You can also arrive by train on the line from Florence across the Val di Sieve.
-  All of Mugello's municipalities are well connected by road with public transport.
-  In addition to traditional modes of transport, you can also discover the Mugello by bike, motorbike, on foot and... on horseback!
